



Founder's Day Cake Bake

Guidelines:

- ❖ Each contestant entering a cake must enter a cake that is NO SMALLER than a 9x13, or a double layer 9" round
- ❖ All baked goods must be baked, finished and from scratch
- ❖ **No commercially purchased entries in any category- No raw or uncooked eggs.**
- ❖ Baked goods are to be prepared in a sanitary manner
- ❖ All entries must be placed on or in a disposable base or pan. We will not be responsible for returning bases or pans or internal supports
- ❖ All entries will be judged then sold by auction or slice. All proceeds will benefit Wade Community Park
- ❖ Each baked item should be marked with the following;
 1. Name of the baked good
 2. List of ingredients including, but not limited to (milk, eggs, peanuts, tree nuts, fish, shellfish, soy, wheat)
- ❖ Every entry needs to be submitted between 8:30 am and 10:00 am on the morning of the event at the Wade Community Building located at 4070 Church St. in Wade
- ❖ All participants must be amateur
- ❖ Any leftover items will become the property of the Town of Wade

Cake Judging Criteria:

- ❖ There will be two categories for judging: Old Time Cakes and Pound Cakes
- ❖ Judging will commence promptly at 12 pm. Judges will judge on a point system 1-5 based on the following criteria;
 1. General appearance
 2. Flavor
 3. Texture
 4. Originality, Creativity
 5. Authenticity to the Classic Recipe
 6. Creativity
- ❖ Awards and prizes will be given in the categories listed above
- ❖ All entries will be auctioned or sold by the slice at 1:30 pm. All proceeds will go to the Town of Wade to benefit the Wade Community Park.

Prizes:

- ❖ Prizes will be distributed for each category. One 1st place and one 2nd place.
- ❖ List Prizes here...
 - A. 1st Place – Trophy and \$100 cash prize
 - B. 2nd Place – Trophy and \$50 cash prize
