Vendor Rules and Regulations – June 1, 2019

General Information

The Town of Wade will be celebrating the birth and growth of a great community on June 1, 2019 with its 20th annual Founder's Day. At the Wade Community Park, the celebration will showcase the birth and growth of the community, its churches, schools, and other community organizations, and how the town has grown to be an exemplary community in Cumberland County and North Carolina.

The Founder's Day will begin with a parade that ends at one of the most beautiful community parks in the state. Adorned with ballfields, tennis courts, a great children's area, and beautiful trees, the park will be transformed to a beautiful area replete with all the activities that make for a great festival. Antique farm equipment, a car show, arts and crafts vendors, business and food vendors, games for all ages, and stage entertainment will be just a few of the activities that will make for a great day. More than 5,000 folks from southeastern North Carolina are expected in attendance.

Vendors will be accepted on a first come-first serve basis with duplication of vendors being very selective. There is limited space for vendors. When all spaces are sold, no more vendors will be accepted.

Set Up

Each vendor space will be preassigned. Set up will begin on Friday evening, May 31, from 6:00-8:00 pm and will continue on Saturday morning, June 1, at 7:00 a.m. Uniformed security will be on the grounds on Friday night. More specific check-in information will be sent to registered vendors prior to the festival. Set-up must be completed by 9:00 a.m. and all vehicles removed from the vendor area.

Vendor Clean Up

All vendors are expected keep the area around their site free and clear of trash and garbage and should provide their own garbage bags for such refuse. Bags should be tied and removed to designated dumpsters throughout and at the end of each day.

Power

There is limited power in the vending area. Should you need power, please indicate on your application. No vendor will receive more than 20 amps.. You should plan to provide your own electrical cords of sufficient size to carry your power needs.

Tear Down

Tear down will be at 5:00 on Saturday, June 1 (or, when the entertainment ends) with all vendor equipment, trailers, tents, etc. to be removed no later than 7:00 pm
